LAUNCH OF E-HANDBOOK ON WAREHOUSING STANDARDS

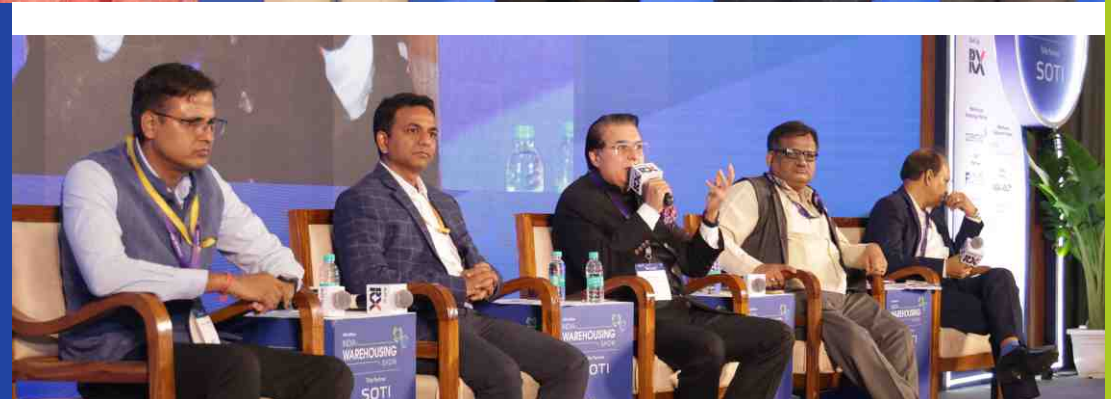
The handbook provides standardized guidelines for India's warehousing and logistics sector.
